



**DOTATION RENAUD REYNEK
STATUTES (extracts)**

Article 1: NAME

The dotation fund is called: "Dotation Renaud Reynek", abbreviated to "DRR".

Article 2: PURPOSE

The purpose of the dotation fund is to support and coordinate all the initiatives of a **cultural** nature that are in the public interest, while focusing more particularly on promoting and safeguarding the poetry of Suzanne Renaud, who comes from the Dauphiné region, and the graphic work of her husband, the engraver and poet, Bohuslav Reynek.

The dotation fund will be used to promote and facilitate the development of fundraising events and shows aimed at financing initiatives that are in the public interest referred to in the paragraphs above.

Article 3: MEANS OF ACTION

In order to develop its corporate purpose, the fund may:

- finance and foster the development of any work that contributes to its purpose;
- develop partnerships with any organisation that develops similar and/or related activities;
- use all means available to raise funds aimed at facilitating the development of the fund's purpose;
- support any public interest organisation that pursues similar goals to its own or goals that are in keeping with an extension of its purpose;
- promote the use of its assets for the benefit of charitable organisations working in areas that are in keeping with its purpose;
- lend, rent and provide human and material resources to projects that are in keeping with its purpose;
- organise conferences, seminars, congresses and training courses aimed at developing its activities and those of the public-interest organisations that it intends to support;
- print any publications and other information documents.

Article 4: REGISTERED OFFICE

The registered office of the dotation fund is located 27 chemin de l'Église 38240 Meylan, France.

Article 5: TERM

The dotation fund is established for an unlimited term.
